**Greetings Neighbors!** We're looking forward to seeing you all out and about now that spring has arrived! Just a few reminders as we all start to spend more time enjoying our yards:

Lawn Maintenance: The City of Dublin requires us to prevent weeds and grass from exceeding six inches. So please keep your lawns mowed. Also remember the lawn strip between sidewalks and the curb is also your responsibility for mowing. The city encourages grass clippings be left on the lawn to reduce the amount of yard waste. For residential yard waste collection, place leaves and grass clippings in biodegradable yard waste paper bags or in a trash can designated for yard waste only. Mondays are the day for pick up of these bags.

Green space: Please do not cut down or remove any area around your house that is owned by the City of Dublin and is labeled as "green space". This also includes trees that are in the public right-of-way (the lawn strip between sidewalks and the curb) and are owned by the City of Dublin. The City's Forestry Staff is responsible for the pruning of these trees and asks that homeowners not do any pruning on their own. Any questions on what is or is not green space should be directed to the City of Dublin.

Exterior Improvements: Please remember that some exterior modifications to your home need to be approved by the Design Control Committee. For more information go to our website:
